





Create tags that act as quick reference, reminders and notes.

Manage many applicants quickly by assessing them as they are submitted, using tags and internal notes.





Quick Reference Tags

Generate quick reference tags

Tags act as quick reference, reminders and notes.

Common tags are related to sectors, gender of applicant, stage and country of the startup. Create your custom tag, i.e. 'fintech' and filter for the respective applications any time.



Pro tip: "Future Potential" Tags


There may be applications that fall short of the requirements now, however show potential and should be revisited in the future.

The data generated is yours indefinitely. Use tags to mark potential for future programs or those suitable for other opportunities.


Track all the activities related to the open application e.g. where it was moved to and by who.

Exports in your preferred format, of all received applications, or a selection of them, i.e. every application you gave a 'future potential' tag to, during your pre-screening assessment.



Pro Filtering

Pro tip: high-speed prescreening

This strategy can help you to quickly identify the weak/strong applications, as you can directly compare key questions. Manage your results by tagging in bulk or changing their status (e.g. to 'rejected'). Click on 'Quick selection tool'.

Select the questions you want to look at or compare and click on 'update results.



Make use of the search bar on the right to filter for specific keywords in open questions or answers you provided in selection questions, i.e. for revenue search who stated '\$500K +' given that was one of the selection answers you provided in your application form.



Click on the field and the questions will appear in a drop down.



Click on 'Select all' and move them in one click or give them a suitable tag, i.e. 'high revenue'.
